Co-ordination Bingo Adult Guidance

Children play in groups of up to 6.

Contents:

5 co-ordination bingo cards.

You will also need:

Once dice per group.

Pencils.

Objective of the game:

To be the first to complete their bingo card.

How to play:

- Each group chooses a 'caller'. The caller has the dice.
- Each other player chooses a bingo card.
- The caller rolls the dice and calls the conjunction represented by the number rolled on their caller card. They can also mark off how many times each conjunction has been called on this card.
- The rest of the players look at their bingo card. If a player can use the conjunction in one of their sentences, they write the conjunction within the middle box to join the sentences together. Note only one sentence can be completed per call.
- The first person to fill their card and call bingo wins. The caller is responsible for checking the winner's card.
